ADOPTION OF CONSTITUTION

44. This Constitution shall be considered adopted upon the Club's Application for affiliation with the A.A.A. Ltd.

COMMON SEAL

- (a) The Common Seal of the Branch shall be kept in the custody of the Secretary.
- (b) The Common Seal shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of the Committee and the affixing of the Common Seal shall be attested by the signatures either of two members of the Committee or of one member of the Committee and of the Officer of the Branch.

ALTERATION OF THE CONSTITUTION AND STATEMENT OF PURPOSES

- (a) A member intending to propose an alteration to the Constitution and Statement of Purposes shall give written notice of the proposed alteration to the Secretary of the A.A.A. Ltd.
- (b) An alteration shall be made to the Constitution or Statement of Purposes whether by the addition of a new rule or the repeal or amendment of an existing rule or otherwise except by resolution passed by a majority of three-fourths of the members present and entitled to vote at an Annual or Special General Meeting convened by notice specifying the proposed alteration and which is approved by the A.A.A. Ltd.
